Command Line Version User's Guide 7z.exe is the command line version of 7-Zip. 7z.exe uses 7z.dll from the 7-Zip package. 7z.dll is used by the 7-Zip File Manager also. 7za.exe (a = alone) is a standalone version of 7-Zip. 7za.exe supports only 7z, xz, lzma, cab, zip, gzip, bzip2 and tar formats. 7za.exe doesn't use external modules.

New versions of 7-Zip (starting from version 15.06) use another file sorting order by default for solid 7z archives. Old version of 7-Zip (before version 15.06) used file sorting "by type" ("by extension"). New version of 7-Zip supports two sorting orders: sorting by name - default order.

7-Zip is a file archiver with the highest compression ratio. The program supports 7z (that implements LZMA compression algorithm), ZIP, CAB, ARJ, GZIP, BZIP2, TAR, CPIO, RPM and DEB formats. Compression ratio in the new 7z format is 30-50% better than ratio in ZIP format. 7z uses plugins to handle archives.
