Open SQL Server Management Studio and connect to your SQL Server instance. In the Object Explorer panel (located on the left side), Expand the database in which to create the new database user. Expand Security and then Users. Right-click on Users and then select New User.

Click on Browse button and select your SQL database user and click OK. Once again click on OK button from "Select Users or Roles" Dialog box. How to assign particular permissions to SQL server ...

In the last case (value R), the user has no explicit privileges but can perform an activity if a role to which the user belongs has the appropriate permission. To manage permissions for a user or role using Management Studio, expand the server and expand Databases. Right-click the database and click Properties.

Logins and Users are basic security concepts in SQL Server. They are often, and incorrectly, considered to be pretty much one in the same so it is sometimes confusing to some SQL Server users. Another important security concept tied to a login and user in SQL Server is Security Identifiers (SID).

Install the Microsoft SQL Server Management Studio (SSMS) from the Microsoft website. Stop the SQL service and restart the service in single-user mode. The easiest way to do this is in administrator command prompt. This prevents other users from
