I-864P: Poverty Guidelines - USCIS Guide

The legal purpose of this Affidavit is to prove that, according to the numbers set forth within the U.S. Poverty Guidelines, the U.S. sponsor's household income is high enough to support the immigrating family members at 125% or more of U.S. poverty line levels, after taking into account anyone already living with or dependent on the U.S. sponsor.

These poverty guidelines remain in effect for use on the Form I-864 Affidavit of Support starting from March 2, 2020 to Spring of 2021 in which new guidelines will go into effect. For the 48 Contiguous States, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the U.S. Virgin Islands, and Guam: Sponsor's Household Size. 100% Poverty Line.

I-864P: Poverty Guidelines for family based green card

To qualify for the reduced fee, your documented annual household income must be greater than 150 percent and not more than 200 percent of the Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPG), at the time of filing, based on your household size. The secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services establishes the Federal Poverty Guidelines annually.

You must show that your household income is equal to or higher than 125% of the U.S. poverty level for your household size. (Your household size includes you, your dependents, any relatives living with you, and the immigrants you are sponsoring.)

2009 Poverty Guidelines, Federal Register Notice | ASPE

These guidelines, also called Federal Poverty Levels (FPLs), are based on the size of a household and the state in which one resides. FPLs are the same in 48 of the 50 states. The two exceptions are Alaska and Hawaii, which have higher Federal Poverty Levels due to the higher cost of living.

For example, the poverty level for a household of four in 2020 is an annual income of \$26,200. To get the poverty level for larger families, add \$4,480 for each additional person in the household. For smaller families, subtract \$4,480 per person. Guidelines for Alaska and Hawaii are higher since it's more expensive to live there.

The HHS has the authority to update the poverty guidelines under Federal statute (see 42 U.S.C. 9902(2)). The USCIS will update the Form I-864P, HHS Poverty Guidelines for Affidavit of Support, to reflect the new poverty guidelines. As we noted, the HHS poverty guidelines are relevant to immigration law in the public charge and fee waiver contexts.
