This database includes parish records with dates ranging from 1754 up until 1916. Couples were usually married in the bride's parish. Marriage records typically include the bride and groom's names, residence, date and location of the marriage, names of witnesses, condition (bachelor, spinster, widow, or widower) and the name of the officiant.
